

THE UNIFORM CODE

How students dress for school plays an important part in how they behave and helps to set the right expectations and standards as a community. Any student failing or refusing to follow these guidelines will have their movement around school restricted until they are able to do so.

With all aspects of uniform we do our utmost to provide images of acceptable and unacceptable uniform on the school website to allow correct choices to be made. If in doubt, please refer to this information and ask for advice before making purchases.

It is at the discretion of the school to make decisions regarding uniform that does not conform to the requirements set out in this guide. Please remember that choosing Llanfyllin High School implies a willingness to conform to our school uniform guidelines at all times. This policy is also endorsed by the school's Governing Body.

The Dress Code

School v neck jumper with logo. **No other jumper/ sweater or hoodie will be allowed at any time.** School Polo shirt with logo

Skirts must be no shorter than 2cm above the knee with no fashion detailing such as pockets, patches or zips and should not cling to the body or ride up whilst walking.

Examples of skirts that are acceptable as school uniform



Matching **Socks** or tights must be plain, non-patterned in white, black or grey.

Plain black trousers or skirt.

Trousers must be smart school style only. Trousers must not be skin tight, hipster or legging style. Material should not be cord, denim, cotton jeans style and trousers should not contain cargo pockets, jeans style rivets or logo labels (e.g. a red label on the back pocket).

Guidance on Girls Trousers from Named Suppliers to support you in your choices:

For example Miss Sexy, Skinny or Hipster trousers and similar are not suitable as school trousers. These are fashion choices.




Shoes (or boots worn under trousers only) must be plain black leather style not canvas, in any sensible style with a maximum of 2cm heel. Footwear must not have coloured flashes in any part of the shoe, buckles or eyelets must be black. Trainers or canvas style pumps or Ugg style boots are not permitted.

Jewellery – should be one wrist watch, one plain earstud in each ear maximum. Any jewellery worn that does not conform to the uniform code will be confiscated. No nose, eyebrow, tongue jewellery or ear spike, stretcher/ expander is to be worn. No bands,

bangles, rings, necklaces or chains to be worn. During PE/Games lessons all jewellery is to be removed for safety.

NB. Our advice is that piercing should only take place at the beginning of the summer holiday so that pupils (particularly with facial piercing) can conform with the above. Plasters covering recent piercings/ studs are not an acceptable alternative.

Hair Styles – hair styles should be of a natural colour. They should be such that they do not draw attention and be safe and practical for the school environment. Fashion hair accessories (e.g. bows and flowers) or ‘tram-lines’/ hair patterns are not acceptable. Otherwise, movement around school will be restricted.

Make-up and nail varnish – are not to be worn in school. Pupils not conforming will be made to remove them. A contribution to the cost of removal wipes is expected for persistent infringement.

Belt – Should be plain black in a style suitable to school (e.g. no large buckles etc).

PE Kit

Shorts/ Skorts	School shorts or skorts. (No logo e.g. Nike)
Shirt	Girls: Sky blue polo shirt. Boys: Rugby or polo shirt.
Socks	School Games Socks.
Footwear	Boys football boots for games in the winter. Trainers at other times. Girls trainers for all lessons.
Swimming kit	Shorts/trunks for boys. Swimming costume for girls.

Any extreme fashion which may from time to time become popular should be reserved for leisure wear outside school and should not be worn in school.
